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he Hamptons is the number-one destination for New Yorkers fleeing the city and its summer heat. A group of towns at the tip of Long Island, around 100 miles drive from Manhattan, the Hamptons offer a laidback, beachy atmosphere complete with ocean breezes, seafood restaurants and plenty of rustic charm. At the eastern-most point of the peninsular lies the town of Montauk, where this traditional-on-the-outside, modern-on-the-inside holiday home is located. The house belongs to Paige West, one of the country's top art collectors, who commissioned designer Ghislaine Viñas to create her dream summer holiday home.

Ghislaine is known for designs that exude playfulness, joy and spontaneity and this Montauk beach house is no different. "Summer is bright, inspiring and fun, so that's what this summer house is all about," explains Ghislaine,

who begins all her projects by finding out what the client wants to feel when they're in the space, whether that's a residential home or a commercial property. "It was very collaborative. Paige wanted something that fitted her personality like a glove, and I think it really embodies her and her family."

In order to build a narrative for the house, Ghislaine and Paige created the portmanteau 'Floritauk' combining kitschy Florida (where the family's ancestors are from) with a cool, laid-back, modern Montauk surf vibe.







around two years to complete. Many of the furniture pieces have a beach feel, so there's plenty of vintage mixed with modern pieces and lots of custom pieces, too. Rattan and bamboo add to the laidback vibe, as do the tropical prints found on fabrics and wallpapers.

On the top floor, Ghislaine worked with all shades of blue, "But you don't even really notice this as you flow from room to room because there's so much white everywhere, too." On the middle floor, she mixed things up a bit and incorporated some greens into the design. And on the ground floor? "The colours here are based on an image of a bowl of citrus fruit Paige gave me," says Ghislaine. "Lemons, limes, oranges and grapefruits are what we riffed off! Lots of clean, bright white walls but with good energising colour to make you feel happy." And, of course, the art is all selected by Paige thanks to her work as art collector and curator.

Ghislaine's main colour inspiration is nature. "I recently started looking at images of sea slugs for colour and pattern inspiration. I'm also inspired by modern and old Dutch design." Ghislaine is originally from the Netherlands and was raised in South Africa, which has majorly influenced her colour choices: "I love traditional Dutch colours – blues, reds, yellows, and greens, as well as browns and burgundy colours," she says.

And what's next for Ghislaine Viñas? "Any project where the client wants to try something interesting and fun," she says. "I don't have to do projects with lots of colour or loud energy. I can design in a whisper as well. We just got hired for the interior of a 200-year-old farmhouse and the client wants her house to feel like a combination of a Wes Anderson movie and an English country house on acid.
